

Credits

1. All bachelor's degree programs adopt the credit system. To be eligible for admission to the degree, students have to complete all the courses and gain the required credits as stipulated in the study plan, within the study period mentioned above. For details, please refer to Chapter VII Graduation. However, this period may be extended if they cannot enroll according to the study plan assigned by the University. In all cases, students must meet the requirements for graduation within the maximum study period or the bachelor's degree will not be conferred. Therefore, students have to acquaint themselves with their study plan and enroll in courses accordingly. For more details and queries, please contact the respective Faculty Office / Department of General Education directly.
2. According to the requirements for admission, some of the prospective students have to first complete and obtain a passing grade in Basic Chinese, Basic English or Basic Mathematics, which are the pre-requisites for University Chinese, University English, Advanced Mathematics, Calculus and Applied Mathematics, etc. (except under special circumstances). Since these are supplementary courses for strengthening the foundation of the students, they are thus not included in the study plan of the bachelor's degree programs and no credits will be earned from them.
