



【 Guidelines for Health Examination 】

Applicable for Local students

- 1 All local new students must upload the completed “Health Examination Report” during online registration in Late July. The original report should be submitted to the Registry during in-person registration in Late August. The report suggests whether they are physically fit to pursue study at the University.

The completed Health Examination Report

⚠️ should have signature and stamp of the doctor, otherwise it will be deemed as invalid.

Students should complete the health examination on or after May 1, 2026.

- ▶ If students have had health examination on or after May 1, 2026 at local hospital, they can either ask the local hospital to fill in the “Health Examination Report” of the University or provide the original report to the University Hospital for transfer of related data to the “Health Examination Report”, MOP250-400 extra fee will be charged based on the transfer of data.
- ▶ If the health report submitted is found to be missing information, overdue or not in conformity with the requirements of the University, students should do the supplementary check-up either at local hospital/the Macao Government Health Centers or at the University Hospital where a corresponding supplementary fee will be charged.

- 2 Students can choose “one-stop” or “multi-stops” examination:

Vaccination Students should self-check their own vaccination status before the health examination. Please refer to point 3 below for vaccination requirements.

3 Vaccination Record

According to the laws of Macao Special Administrative Region, all new students to be registered in Macao should present the Vaccination Record updated as per Macao SAR Vaccination Program. The vaccination requirements are listed as below:

▶ During the health examination, students must present valid proof of vaccination of the following vaccines for verification by medical staff:

(1) Macao One Account (login, then click on My Health > Personal Health Record > Vaccination Record > Regular Vaccination) ; or (2) the original copy of Vaccination Record (Individual Vaccination Booklet). Information provided in photo or copy will not be accepted.

⚠ Students should check whether the vaccination in the Health Examination Report are completed with injection date and doctor's signature, otherwise the health examination will be deemed as incomplete.

Item	Dose(s)	Remark
Measles	At least 2 doses	Applicable to students born in 1970 and after, each dose should be injected at least four weeks in between.
Rubella	At least 1 dose	Applicable to students born in 1970 and after.
Diphtheria, Pertussis	At least 1 dose	--
Tetanus toxoid	At least 3 doses	Each dose should be injected at least four weeks in between. The last dose should be injected within the recent 10 years.
Hepatitis B vaccine	3 doses	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Only applicable to students admitted to the programs of Bachelor of Traditional Chinese Medicine, Bachelor of Pharmacy and Bachelor of Medicine & Bachelor of Surgery. ◆ Students should receive Hepatitis B Surface Antigen test and Hepatitis B Surface Antibody test. Students with negative results on antibody test should get booster dose of vaccine.

Students who have the following conditions may be exempted from submitting the proof of vaccination:

- (1) Students already had the disease related to the vaccine as certified by doctor or positive result of serological test, or
- (2) Contraindications for vaccination

Relevant students must present the original copies of the proof of the above conditions during the health examination.

4 Chromatic Sense Checking

4.1 If students admitted to the program of **Bachelor of Science and Bachelor of Science in Artificial Intelligence** are found to have abnormal chromatic sense, they will need to take a supplementary ophthalmological examination conducted by a local hospital in Macao and submit the report during the online registration. The University will evaluate student's eligibility for admission of the related program according to the result of diagnosis.

⚠ Students who fail to submit the ophthalmologist report on time will be deemed as incompleteness of health examination.

Students who need to conduct supplementary examinations must make an appointment with an ophthalmologist and pay for related examinations.

The consultation fee for chromatic sense at the University Hospital is MOP 600 – 1,000; additional examination may be conducted by doctors if necessary and related fee will be charged accordingly.

4.2 If students admitted to the programs of **Bachelor of Traditional Chinese Medicine, Bachelor of Pharmacy in Chinese Medicine, Bachelor of Pharmacy, Bachelor of Food and Nutritional Sciences, Bachelor of Medicine & Bachelor of Surgery, Bachelor of Arts in Art Design, Bachelor of Fine Arts in Digital Media, Bachelor in Film and Television Production and Bachelor in Acting** are found to have abnormal chromatic sense, they will not be able to enroll in these programs. ⚠ Students in such cases should contact the Registry immediately for further arrangement.

<input checked="" type="checkbox"/> No urine test for female students during menstruation (can attend other tests as usual). Student should go to attend urine test three days after menstruation.	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/> X-ray is not allowed during pregnancy.
<input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Cooperate with the doctor, truthfully answer the questions and provide medical history without any concealment.
