



【 Guidelines for Health Examination 】

Applicable for Non-local students

- 1 All non-local students must go to the **University Hospital** upon their arrival in Macao in late August to complete the required health examination procedures and submit/show the vaccination record. The “Health Examination Report” will indicate whether they are physically fit to pursue study at the University.

The health examination fee (for students admitted to medical programs*: MOP780, others: MOP620), which is indicated in the Debit Note for the first installment of tuition fee for 2026/2027 has to be paid together with the tuition fee.

** Students admitted to the programs of Bachelor of Traditional Chinese Medicine, Bachelor of Pharmacy and Bachelor of Medicine & Bachelor of Surgery*

- ▶ This fee already includes the administration fee for completing the health report, physical examination and examination for chromatic sense, chest x-ray, blood screening and urine routine. If the examination result is found to be abnormal, students may need to pay an extra fee for supplementary check-up. Please check with the University Hospital for details.



Please note: Overdue/failure to complete all health examination items as required will be deemed as incompleteness of in-person registration procedures, the University will have the right to terminate the student’s eligibility for admission or his/her student status.

Students whose admission is cancelled will not be allowed to participate in any classes, examinations, and other related activities of the University. To avoid delays, students should take the health examination on time and check the status and the result of the health examination as instructed in Section 5.3.

2 Date and Venue

- 2.1 Making Appointment for Health Examination: non-local students whose payment of tuition fees have been verified by the Finance Office would receive the notice for making online appointments. Generally, this begins in mid August*.
- 2.2 After appointment is successfully made, students must bring along the documents as listed in Point 5.2 to the University Hospital at the reserved time slot for health examination.

3 Vaccination Record

According to the laws of Macao Special Administrative Region, all new students to be registered in Macao should present the Vaccination Record updated as per Macao SAR Vaccination Program. The vaccination requirements are listed as below:



Students must complete the vaccination in their hometown before coming to Macao.

Vaccination records issued by the hometown hospital, Disease Control and Prevention Center or vaccination unit should be brought to Macao and presented during Health Examination.

Remarks(4)

▶ **During the health examination, students should present the original copy of the valid proof of vaccination* (e.g., vaccine booklet, vaccination certificate) for verification of the following vaccines by medical staff.**

*Remarks:

- (1) The proof of vaccination (e.g., vaccine booklet, vaccination certificate) must be the original copy, photocopies or photographs of the documents will not be accepted.
- (2) Original copy of household registration or certificate of change of name is required for verification if the name on the vaccine certification does not match the name on the identification document.
- (3) Any correction of personal information on the vaccine certification should be stamped by the organization which issued the certificate.
- (4) If the vaccine certification has been lost, please prepare other proofs as replacement according to Q3 of the [Frequently Ask Questions of Health Examination](#) before coming to Macao.
- (5) If the student's country/province/city has an officially recognized electronic vaccination record (for the following vaccines), the student can login to the relevant electronic vaccination record system/app at the time of health examination at the University Hospital and provide the record to medical staff for verification.

Note: screenshots are not accepted.

Item	Dose(s)	Remark
Measles	At least 2 doses	Applicable to students born in 1970 and after, each dose should be injected at least four weeks in between.
Rubella	At least 1 dose	Applicable to students born in 1970 and after.
Diphtheria, Pertussis	At least 1 dose	--
Tetanus toxoid	At least 3 doses	Each dose should be injected at least four weeks in between. The last dose should be injected within the recent 10 years.
Hepatitis B vaccine	3 doses	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Only applicable to students admitted to the programs of Bachelor of Traditional Chinese Medicine, Bachelor of Pharmacy and Bachelor of Medicine & Bachelor of Surgery. ◆ Students should receive Hepatitis B Surface Antigen test and Hepatitis B Surface Antibody test. Students with negative results on antibody test should get booster dose of vaccine.
Poliomyelitis	At least 4 doses	Only applicable to students from Pakistan and Afghanistan. Each dose should be injected at least four weeks in between.

Students who have the following conditions may be exempted from submitting the proof of vaccination:

- (1) Students already had the disease related to the vaccine as certified by doctor or positive result of serological test, or
- (2) Contraindications for vaccination

Relevant students must present the original copies of the proof of the above conditions during the health examination.

4 Chromatic Sense Checking

- 4.1 If students admitted to the program of **Bachelor of Science and Bachelor of Science in Artificial Intelligence** are found to have abnormal chromatic sense, they will need to take a supplementary ophthalmological examination at the University Hospital (or other Macao Local hospitals) and the report must be submitted to University Hospital (Executive Health Management Centre) as soon as possible. The University will evaluate student's eligibility for admission of the related program according to the result of diagnosis. ⚠️ Students who fail to submit the ophthalmologist report on time will be deemed as incompleteness of health examination.
- 4.2 If students admitted to the programs of **Bachelor of Traditional Chinese Medicine, Bachelor of Pharmacy in Chinese Medicine, Bachelor of Pharmacy, Bachelor of Food and Nutritional Sciences, Bachelor of Medicine & Bachelor of Surgery, Bachelor of Arts in Art Design, Bachelor of Fine Arts in Digital Media, Bachelor in Film and Television Production and Bachelor in Acting** are found to have abnormal chromatic sense, they will not be able to enroll in these programs. ⚠️ Students in such cases should contact the Academic Registry immediately for further arrangement.

Students who need to conduct supplementary examinations must make an appointment with an ophthalmologist and pay for related examinations.

The consultation fee for chromatic sense at the University Hospital is MOP 600 – 1,000; additional examination may be required if necessary and related fee will be charged accordingly.

<input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Cooperate with the doctor, truthfully answer the questions and provide medical history without any concealment.	

- 5.2 [On the day of the health examination](#) Please bring along and present the following documents to the University Hospital:

<input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Identity card, passport or "Permit for travelling to and from Hong Kong and Macao".	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/> The appointment for Health Examination (Must complete the Questionnaire on Health History before making appointment).

5.3 [Check status of Health Examination Result](#)

- ◆ After the health examination at University Hospital, **students should pay attention to the status by themselves through the following methods until it shows the result of each health examination items are all completed or “Completed (Fit)”:**

- Login to Student Portal* (<https://i.must.edu.mo>) / WeMust Student APP, select “Applications > MUST Life (Orientation) > In-Person Registration > Health Examination” to access the related webpage;
- Check the status of each health examination items on the above mentioned webpage (normally you will be notified of the status one week after the health examination, and the results might be provided separately depending on the examination status; therefore, please login to this webpage appropriately from time to time and check.
- If all items of health examination have been completed, students can click on “Health Examination Report” on the above mentioned webpage to check the complete report.

*The login account and password will be issued to students starting in late July after the tuition fee payment has been verified.

- ◆ Please note: University Hospital might request some students to attend re-examination / supplementary examination according to the condition of the students.
- Therefore, students should pay attention to whether there are remarks on the health examination page on WEMUST / report, or notification from the hospital.
