

General information about Multiple Mini Interviews (MMI) to students applying the program of Bachelor of Medicine & Bachelor of Surgery (Year 2023)

During the MMI, candidate will rotate up to two interview stations. **Station 1**: Motivation & language skills; Station 2: Extracurricular activities & dealing with stress. Language of instruction will be in English. We will conduct MMI (Multiple Mini Interview) via Zoom. The faculty will send email to the candidates regarding the Zoom Meeting IDs and time slots for the two stations. Candidates should enter the Zoom station in an ascending numerical order (Zoom Station 1 > Zoom Station 2). All candidates will wait in the waiting room until the interview time arrives. Only one candidate is allowed to admit into the Zoom Meeting Stations. Your interviewer will interact with you for 7 minutes in each station. When one station finished, you need to insert another Meeting ID. There will be 1 minute spare time in between two stations. Total interview duration shall be approximately sixteen minutes. Candidates SHOULD present the valid personal identification documents on the screen when attending the Zoom interview. Those who fail to present the valid ID on the screen are deemed to be disqualified from the Zoom interview. Please be patient!
