2. Notes for Application

- 2.1 Applicants of Bachelor of Medicine & Bachelor of Surgery must be from the science stream and must have knowledge in chemistry and biology. Therefore, applicants are required to submit the transcripts of the final three years (Form 4 to Form 6) in secondary education within the application period. The transcripts submitted must contain chemistry grades (and biology grades are preferable). Mainland China applicants may provide the National College Entrance Examination (NCEE) result and Chemistry result of High School Academic Proficiency Test. Late submission will not be accepted and the University will only consider applicants' other choices.
- 2.2 Applicants who wish to apply for Bachelor of Medicine & Bachelor of Surgery must take it as their first choice.
- 2.3 This program adopts the academic year system. Details about the course syllabus and study plan can be checked from the [MUST website](#).
- 2.4 If Multiple Mini Interview are required, the details about the arrangement of interviews will be notified by the Faculty of Medicine. Notes for interview can be found from the [website](#).
- 2.5 Applicants who get admitted must register in the program that is specified on the acceptance letter.

4. Admission Requirements

- 4.1 General Requirements
- 4.1.1 Applicants must have normal chromatic sense.
- 4.1.2 Applicants must have a great command of Chinese and English in writing and verbal communication.
- 4.1.3 Transcripts of the final three years (Form 4 to Form 6)* in secondary education must contain chemistry grades (and biology grades are preferable).
* Potential graduates of the current academic year should provide the latest transcript containing grades of the most recent semester.
- 4.1.4 Provide Chemistry result of High School Academic Proficiency Test and the National College Entrance Examination (NCEE), applicants whose National College Entrance Examination (NCEE) results include Natural Sciences or Chemistry would be given priority consideration.
- 4.2 Requirements for "Admission through Written Examination"
- 4.2.1 Obtained the qualifications stated in point 4.1 above; and
- 4.2.2 Graduated from Form 6 or equivalent / above; or currently studying in Form 6 or equivalent (such as the Pre-University Studies at Macau University of Science and Technology); or aged 23 or above on September 1, 2021.
- Except for those who have been approved of examination exemption*, applicants who apply for Admission through Written Examination are required to sit for the Admission Examinations (JAE Examinations) in Chinese, English and Mathematics**. * Exemption from Examination:

- (1) Applicants with the following qualifications may apply for exemption from taking Chinese, English and Mathematics examinations:

- (2) Application for Exemption: Apart from completing the online application procedures, applicants who want to apply for exemption from admission examinations are also required to submit in person the following documents to the Academic Registry before application deadline:
- Completed 「Application for Admission Examination Exemption」 (Downloaded from the [University Website > Admission > Undergraduate > More Information > Forms Download](#));
 - Original and copy of academic certification documents corresponding to the qualifications for exemption;
 - Original and copy of valid identification documents.
- (3) Applicants will be informed of the application result via e-mail no later than one week before the examination. Applicants are required to sit for the examination of subjects that are not approved for exemption

** Bonus schemes for Delta Asia Quiz

- (1) Application Qualification: application with the following qualifications may apply for “Bonus Scheme for Written Examination”:
- Applicants who have been awarded First/Second/Third prize of Delta Asia Quiz during the last three years of secondary school study.

- (2) Application method: Apart from completing the online application procedures, applicants of the “Bonus Scheme for Written Examination” are also required to submit the following documents to Academic Registry before the application deadline:
- Written application by the applicants: it should include the application number, name, and a valid telephone number of the applicants and indicates as “Application for the Bonus Scheme for Written Examination”.
 - copy of the certificate/qualification of awards.
 - copy of valid identification document.
- (3) Application Result:
Upon verification and assessment by the University, applicants may receive a bonus of 30 to 50 marks added to the results of Languages and Mathematics Admission Examinations which are required for the programs applied. (For example, if an applicant is required to take three examination subjects and 40 marks is to be granted upon verification and assessment, he/she will receive this bonus mark for each of the three subjects, adding a total of 120 bonus marks towards the total score.)
