

Attachment 1: Exemption from Examination and Bonus Schemes (Applicable to Applicants who apply for Admission through Written Examination)

I. Exemption from Examination

■ Application Requirement

Applicants with the following qualifications may apply for exemption from taking Chinese, English and Mathematics examinations:

Subject for Exemption	Requirements
Chinese	Applicants without basic education in Chinese Language during the last three years of study in secondary education. <small>Remarks 1 & 2</small>
English <small>Remarks 3</small>	Obtained any of the following qualifications: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● International English Language Testing System (IELTS): Band 6.0 or above ● Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL): Paper-based test: 550 or above; Computer-based test: 213 or above; Internet-based test: 79 or above
Mathematics	Awarded any prizes in the Mathematical Olympiad competition; or Awarded the second prize or above in the high school group in the Individual Category of Inter-School Mathematics Competition organized by the Education and Youth Affairs Bureau (DSEDJ)

Remark 1: According to the requirements of the programs, applicants whose choices include the programs of Bachelor of Laws, Bachelor of Traditional Chinese Medicine, Bachelor of Pharmacy in Chinese Medicine, Bachelor of Pharmacy, Bachelor of Food and Nutritional Sciences or Bachelor of Arts in Art Design are required to take Chinese examination.

Remark 2: Applicants who have been exempted from the Chinese examination may have to take the aptitude test in Chinese. They also need to take Chinese language or culture related courses taught in English for substitution of the Chinese courses prescribed in the study plan of admitted program.

Remark 3: The qualifications for applying exemption from English examinations are different for the applicants of Bachelor of Medicine & Bachelor of Surgery. Please click [here](#) for details.

(Note: Internet-based test, paper-based test and revised TOEFL paper-delivered test grades results will only be valid if issued within 2 years from the test date).

■ Application Method

Apart from completing the online application procedures, applicants who want to apply for exemption from admission examinations are also required to submit the following documents **in person** to the Academic Registry before application deadline * at Student Service Center (Academic Registry Counter) **:

- 1) The completed form “Application for admission examination exemption” (Downloaded from the [University Website > Admission > Undergraduate Programs > More Information > Forms Download](#))
- 2) Copy of academic certification documents corresponding to the qualifications for exemption (Original for verification);
- 3) Copy of valid identification documents (Original for verification).

*Recommended Macao students who need to take the Joint Admission Examination can apply for exemption within the period of Jan 4 – 18, 2023.

■ Application Result

- 1) Applicants will be informed of the application result via e-mail no later than one week before the examination.
- 2) Applicants are required to sit for the examination of subjects that are not approved for exemption.

II. Bonus schemes for Delta Asia Quiz

Applicants with the following qualifications may apply for the bonus scheme for Written Examination:

■ **Qualifications Requirement:**

Applicants who have been awarded First/Second/Third prize of Delta Asia Quiz during the last three years of secondary school study.

■ **Application Method**

Apart from completing the online application procedures, applicants of the bonus scheme are also required to submit the following documents to the Academic Registry before application deadline * at Student Service Center (Academic Registry Counter).

- 1) Written application by the applicants. It should include the application number, name, and a valid contact number of the applicants and indicates as "Application for the Bonus Scheme for Written Examination".
- 2) Copy of the certificate/qualification of awards (Original for verification).
- 3) Copy of valid identification document (Original for verification).

■ **Application Result**

Upon verification and assessment by the University, applicants may receive a bonus of 30 to 50 marks added to the results of Languages and Mathematics Admission Examinations which are required for the programs applied. (For example, if an applicant is required to take three examination subjects and 40 marks is to be granted upon verification and assessment, he/she will receive this bonus mark for each of the three subjects, adding a total of 120 bonus marks towards the total score.)
