Notes:

- 1. Tuition fees are normally paid in two installments each academic year, the first installment is before registration (before the commencement of the first semester) and the second installment would be before the commencement of the second semester. Please refer to the latest notice from the Finance Office via Student Portal (<a href="https://i.must.edu.mo">https://i.must.edu.mo</a>) on the University homepage.
  - Students of Faculty of Chinese Medicine have to pay an additional charge for experimental material: Bachelor of Biomedicine and Bachelor of Traditional Chinese Medicine is HKD12,000 (Approx. MOP12,378); Bachelor of Pharmacy in Chinese Medicine is HKD40,000 (Approx. MOP41,260). Students of Bachelor of Pharmacy have to pay an additional charge for experimental material of HKD42,000 (Approx. MOP43,323); Students of Bachelor of Food and Nutritional Sciences is HKD20,000 (Approx. MOP20,630). Students of Bachelor of Environmental Science and Engineering is HKD7,500 (Approx. MOP7,737).
  - 3 Students of Bachelor of International Tourism Management and Bachelor of Hotel Management have to pay an additional charge for F&B Practice Material Fee of HKD1,500(Approx. MOP1,548). Students of Bachelor of Hotel Management have to pay an additional charge for F&B Practice Material Fee for individual elective subjects. Details refer to the latest student handbook.
  - 4. Students of Bachelor of Medicine & Bachelor of Surgery have to pay the tuition fees for clinical internship year (i.e. the 6th year) which is varied with the choice of country and hospital chose for the internship. Please refer to the latest announcement of the University.
  - 5. Students of Bachelor of Traditional Chinese Medicine and Bachelor of Pharmacy have to pay the tuition fees for clinical internship year (i.e. the 5th year). The fees will be notified later, please refer to the latest announcement of the University.
  - 6. The above tuition fee does not include fees for taking excess credits, supplementary courses, course retakes or auditing, etc., all of which does not fall within expenses of a normal study plan. Therefore, students must pay the relevant additional fees. For details of fees for taking excess credits, course retakes or auditing please refer to the latest student handbook.
  - 7. For students of Undergraduate Programmes who need to take supplementary courses, an additional tuition fee shall be applied. The tuition fee for the following subjects in each semester are as follows: HKD15,000(Approx. MOP15,473) per subject of Remedial Chinese, Remedial Mathematics, Remedial English I, Remedial English II.
  - 8. For students of Pre-University Programme who need to take supplementary courses, the tuition fee for the following subjects in each semester are as follows: HKD15,000(Approx. MOP15,473) per subject of Intensive Basic English, Intensive Basic Mathematics.
  - 9. New students have to pay One-Off Admission Miscellaneous Fee HKD2,000(Approx. MOP2,063) before the commencement of the first semester.
  - 10. Tuition fees will be increased by about 5% each year. Fees for next academic year please refer to the latest announcement of the University.
  - 11. New students of 2025/2026 or transferring students have to pay tuition fees as shown in the Tuition Fee Table.

## 2. Caution Fee

New students must pay caution fee of HKD10,000 (Approximately MOP10,315) before admission to any of our University program. Caution fee is refundable on request, after registration and deduction against any outstanding penalties or fees in arrears and upon their completion of the withdrawal procedures of the program of study.

## 3. Notes

- 1) Payment can be settled in HKD or MOP.
- 2) All banking charges incurred will be borne by students.
- 3) Students must pay tuition fee for all enrolled courses of the respective semester / the whole semester tuition fee, no matter whether they have completed the course/semester or not.
- 4) All paid fees will be handled according to the university's latest announced Policy on Admission Fees.
- 5) Students, registered or non-registered, must accept and abide by all the clauses stated on the Tuition Fee Table.
- 6) Fees will be adjusted each year, please refer to the latest updates.
- 7) The University reserves the final right of arbitration for any disputes arising from payment of tuition fees.
