- Notes :
- Tuition fees are normally paid in two installments each academic year, the first installment is before registration (before the commencement of the first semester) and the second installment would be before the commencement of the second semester. Please refer to the latest notice from the Accounts Office via the electronic bulletin board on the University homepage.
  - Students of Faculty of Chinese Medicine have to pay an additional charge for experimental material: Bachelor of Biomedicine and Bachelor of Traditional Chinese Medicine is HKD8,000 (Approx. MOP8,252); Bachelor of Pharmacy in Chinese Medicine is HKD32,000 (Approx. MOP33,008).
  - Students of Bachelor of Pharmacy have to pay an additional charge for material of HKD32,000 (Approx. MOP33,008).
  - Students of Bachelor of Food and Beverage Management have to pay an additional charge for a) Food and Beverage Training Uniform and Professional Knife Set of HKD7,000 (Approx. MOP7,221) and b) F&B Practice Material Fee: Major in Culinary Art is HKD30,000(Approx. MOP30,945) ; Major in Restaurant Management is HKD20,000(Approx. MOP20,630) .
  - The above tuition fee does not include fees for taking excess credits, fees for supplementary courses, course retakes or auditing, etc., all of which does not fall within expenses of a normal study plan. Therefore, students must pay the relevant additional fees.
  - If students have taken courses with credits exceeding the minimum credit requirement for graduation, the additional tuition fee for taking excess credits has to be paid before completion of the relevant course. Each excess credit of Bachelor of Pharmacy, Bachelor of Biomedicine and Bachelor of Traditional Chinese Medicine are HKD1,900(Approx. MOP1,960), Bachelor of Business Administration, Bachelor of Applied Economics and Bachelor of Arts in Art Design are HKD2,600(Approx. MOP2,682) and other Bachelor's Degree Programme is HKD2,300(Approx. MOP2,373). Please refer to the latest announcement of the University for the minimum credit requirement for graduation.
  - If students need to retake courses, a tuition fee for retaking shall apply. The fee for each credit of the retake course of Bachelor of Pharmacy, Bachelor of Biomedicine and Bachelor of Traditional Chinese Medicine are HKD1,900(Approx. MOP1,960), Bachelor of Business Administration, Bachelor of Applied Economics and Bachelor of Arts in Art Design are HKD2,600(Approx. MOP2,682) and other Bachelor's Degree Programme is HKD2,300(Approx. MOP2,373); whereas for each course of Pre-University Programme will be HKD4,700(Approx. MOP4,849).
  - For students who need to take supplementary foundation courses due to failure in admission examinations/placement tests, an additional tuition fee shall apply. The tuition fee for the following subjects in each semester are as follows: HKD5,000(Approx. MOP5,158)per subject of Foundation Chinese, Foundation Maths; HKD7,300(Approx. MOP7,530) per subject of Foundation English ( I ), Foundation English ( II ).
  - New students have to pay One-Off Admission Miscellaneous Fee HKD2,000(Approx. MOP2,063) before the commencement of the first semester.
  - New students of 2018/2019 or transferring students have to pay tuition fees as shown in the Tuition Fee Table.

#### 2. Caution Fee

New students must pay caution fee of HKD10,000 (Approximately MOP10,315) before admission to any of our University program. Caution fee is refundable on request, after registration and deduction against any outstanding penalties or fees in arrears and upon their completion of the withdrawal procedures of the program of study.

#### 3. Notes

- Payment can be settled in HKD or MOP.
- All banking charges incurred will be borne by students.
- Students must pay tuition fee for all enrolled courses of the respective semester / the whole semester tuition fee, no matter whether they have completed the course/semester or not.
- All fees paid are neither refundable nor transferable.
- Students, registered or non-registered, must accept and abide by all the clauses stated on the Tuition Fee Table.
- Tuition fee, experimental material costs, food & beverage tool package fee and food ingredients costs are made on the yearly basis and are subject to adjustment, please refer to the latest updates.
- The University reserves the final right of arbitration for any disputes arising from payment of tuition fees.
