

Keith Morrison

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Professor Keith Morrison worked at the University of Durham, UK, for 15 years before moving to Macau in 2000, where he has been a Professor of Education, a university Vice-rector and currently Director of Institutional Development at Macau University of Science and Technology. His first degree was in Education, Music and English Literature, and his doctorate thesis focused on critical theory in education. He is the author/co-author of 16 academic books, Co-editor of the international journal *Educational Research and Evaluation* and for over ten years he was the Editor of *Evaluation and Research in Education*. He is the reviewer for over 20 international journals in education, research methods, social sciences and management and has published some 100 refereed academic articles, 130 articles in non-refereed publications, over 30 handbooks on aspects of teaching and learning, and some 50 international conference papers. He has conducted educational consultancies and produced papers, reports and technical reports for governments and research institutions in several countries in South-East Asia, South Africa and Europe. Before moving into higher education he taught in kindergarten, primary and secondary schools in the UK. He is a Fellow of the Royal Society of Arts and his research interests are in education, social science research methods, complexity theory and the philosophy of the social sciences.
