

## Developing Communication Skills for Clinical Practice

**Experienced Clinical communication skills** tutors will provide an integrated approach to teaching these skills. The teaching of basic communication skills will be addressed in simulated clinical consultations to ensure that the relevance of generic skills is understood within the context of medical practice. These simulated consultations will also be used to address concepts of the medical history and the patient-centred approach. **Excellent communication in those brief** moments with patients will ensure that the most is made of that time, and that the patient experience is exceptional. Several steps can be taken to improve communication and to enhance the doctorpatient relationship – and to improve satisfaction and outcomes.
