## **Dr Liu Chak Wan Scholarships**

The Dr Liu Chak Wan Scholarships are made possible by the generosity of Dr Liu, Chancellor of the Macau University of Science & Technology and distinguished businessman and philanthropist who is deeply committed to the cause of education.

### **Degree type and subject**

The Dr Liu Chak Wan Scholarships are available for applicants who are applying to undertake any qualifying 9- or 12-month Master's degree\* offered by Wolfson College and the University of Oxford.

### **Value of award**

Course fees and a grant for living costs for full-time students of £16,500 per year (students on part-time courses will receive a study support grant instead). Awards are made for the full duration of fee liability.

### **Eligibility criteria**

Applicants from all countries will be considered. Applicants must be graduates of the Macau University of Science & Technology.

### **How to apply**

All applicants should apply to the University of Oxford under the standard procedures for graduate degrees for 2021-22 but all applicants must select Wolfson College as their preferred college, and must apply by the January deadline for their eligible programme of study. **Applicants must also confirm their interest in being considered for this award by emailing [admissions@wolfson.ox.ac.uk](mailto:admissions@wolfson.ox.ac.uk) no later than Monday 10 January 2022.** The Scholar will become a member of Wolfson College for the duration of their studies.
