通告: 返校及參與面授課堂須知

因應澳門政府對高等院校面授教學的最新要求,返校參與面授課堂的同學,必須符合提前 14 天返回澳門、珠海或中山之居所,並且若在 8 月 6 日後學生本人或其同住者曾到訪(或身處)澳門、珠海或中山以外地的,須於參與線下課堂前 5 天內完成核酸檢測並持陰性結果。澳門政府將於 9 月 1 日至 5 日期間安排一次性免費核酸檢測,學生可於 8 月 30 日起透過專門平台 https://app.ssm.gov.mo/higheredurnabook 進行預約檢測(請留意,因應大學向澳門政府提交的證件資料,內地生登入時,證件類別應選擇護照項,並輸入內地身份證編號進行預約檢測)。

為配合上述參與面授課堂的要求,同學們須每天登入學生門戶網站 http://i.must.edu.mo或 WeMust Student APP內進行學生健康申報,然後生成澳門科技大學「上課碼」。 <u>自 2021年9月6日起</u>,大學要求所有返校上課的同學須出示<u>當天有效</u>的澳門健康碼綠碼、澳門科技大學「上課碼」綠碼及佩戴口罩,方可進入教學大樓實地參與課堂、考試或活動。大學全面恢復線下面授教學後,學生若不能或拒絕出示上述綠碼而缺席面授課堂,且沒有充份理據及證明者,一般按曠課論。

在此,再次重申按現時澳門政府的防疫要求,於2021年8月6日後或參與面授課堂前14日內,學生本人或其常居地址同住者曾到訪(或身處)澳門、珠海或中山以外地區,則學生必須先返回澳門、珠海、中山滿14日,並須於面授課堂當天持有5天內的陰性核酸檢測結果,才可生成「上課碼」。請同學們按大學8月24日"新學年返校上課須知"要求,盡早規劃回校的行程及安排,且不遲於9月1日前返回澳門、珠海或中山之居所並避免離境(即避免離開澳門、珠海及中山居住地)。另請詳閱附件有關《校園及面授課堂防疫措施及學生須知》的修訂版,並持續關注大學發佈的最新通知。

大學籍此呼籲同學們,在經過評估個人身健康狀況許可情況下,應盡快接種新冠疫苗, 保障個人健康並達致群體免疫效果。

校園及面授課堂防疫措施及學生須知(2021/8/30修訂)

- 學生必須配合澳門特區政府及大學的各項防疫措施,包括:體溫檢測、佩戴口罩、人流管制、 出示健康碼、保持社交距離,健康管理、醫學觀察等。
- 2) 每天自我測量體溫,如出現發熱(耳溫等於或高於38°C/額溫等於或高於37.5°C)、乾咳、乏力、 咽痛、嗅(味)覺減退、腹瀉或其他呼吸道症狀,必須戴上口罩及早就醫,並暫緩上學。
- 3) 每天登錄 WeMust Student APP 進行健康申報,學生必須如實及準確填報學生健康申報的各項資料,資料一經提交不予修改。「上課碼」將按學生申報的資料生成,而相關的生成的條件將按澳門政府及大學最新防疫要求而定。因此,學生必須持續關注最新防疫的資訊和遵守有關的要求。
- 4) 須出示當天有效的澳門健康碼綠碼、澳門科技大學「上課碼」綠碼及佩戴口罩,方可進入教學 大樓實地參與課堂、考試或活動。在大學全面線下授課期間,不能或拒絕出示上述綠碼而缺席 面授課堂者,一般按曠課論。
- 5) 澳門健康碼為黃碼/紅碼或上課碼為紅碼的同學,應即時通知學院/部/所及班導師,由學院/部/所 評估學生情況是否具備充份理據及證明和因應課堂的性質作出適切的處理或教學安排。
- 6) 上課及進行有關教學活動時,應全程佩戴口罩,不要飲食,並盡量與同學之間保持至少1米距離。注意環境、個人及手部衛生,避免交叉感染。
- 7) 校園內,避免聚集,自覺分流使用不同的路徑到達課室/目的地,避免使用電梯。
- 8) 避免離開澳門和跨境流動,減少疫情可能帶來的風險,影響學業或考核。學生應審慎評估跨境的需要並作出自我承擔後果的準備。
- 9) 如遇不可抗力的情況下未能返校上課,同學必須向有關學院/部/所聯繫說明情況,以酌情處理缺勤及適時提供學業支援,以免學業受到影響。
- 10) 由於疫情已屬常態,且不斷在變化,當社區存在一定的風險時,大學會因應情況將課堂暫改為 線上授課,以配合澳門特區政府的防疫措施。因此,同學除為線下學習作出準備外,亦應同時 妥善準備線上學習和考核等的相關設備和配套,以配合隨時實施的應變防疫措施。
- 11) 留意澳門特區政府公佈的最新防疫資訊(https://www.ssm.gov.mo/PreventCOVID-19)及大學的最新公佈,做好個人防疫措施及準備。
- 12) 如對教學安排方面有疑問,請向所屬學院/部/所查詢。

Notice: Notes for Returning to the University for Offline Classes

According to the latest requirements of the Macao SAR Government for face-to-face teaching in higher education institutions, students must return to their residence in Macao, Zhuhai or Zhongshan 14 days before resumption of face-to-face teaching. Those who personally or whose housemates have been to places outside Macao, Zhuhai or Zhongshan after August 6 must complete a nucleic acid test and obtain a negative result within 5 days before attending offline classes. The Macao SAR Government will arrange a one-time free nucleic acid test from September 1 to 5. Students can make an appointment for the test through the Appointment System https://app.ssm.gov.mo/higheredurnabook from August 30. According to the information submitted by the University to the Macao Government, mainland students should select "Others (with passport or travel documents)" as the ID type and enter the PRC ID number for an appointment.

To meet the above requirements of attending offline classes, students are required to login to the Student Portal http://i.must.edu.mo or WeMust Student APP every day for health declaration and obtain a green MUST Class Access Code. Starting from September 6, 2021, all students returning to campus must present valid green Macao Health Code, MUST Class Access Code and wear a mask before entering the academic buildings to participate in classes, examinations or activities. After the University has fully resumed offline teaching, students who are absent from offline classes due to failure or refusal to show the above green codes with no sufficient justification and proof will be regarded as unapproved absence.

To reiterate, in accordance with the current epidemic prevention requirements of the Macao SAR Government, students who personally or whose housemates have been to places outside Macao, Zhuhai or Zhongshan after August 6, 2021 or within 14 days before resumption of offline classes must first return to Macao, Zhuhai, and Zhongshan for 14 days, and have a negative result of nucleic acid test within 5 days on the day of attending offline classes before you can generate the Class Access Code. Students should make preparations and arrangements as early as possible, return to your residence in Macao, Zhuhai or Zhongshan before September 1 and avoid leaving the city of your residence according to the requirements of "Notes for Returning to the University for Classes in the New Academic Year" issued on August 24. Please also read the revised version of "Campus and Classroom Epidemic Prevention Measures and Notes for Students" as attached, and continue to pay attention to the latest announcements issued by the University.

To protect your health and achieve herd immunity, the University urges all students to get COVID-19 vaccines as soon as possible after assessing your personal health status.

Campus and Classroom Epidemic Prevention Measures and Notes for Students (Revised on 2021/8/30)

- 1) Students must comply with the epidemic prevention measures of the Macao SAR Government and the University, including: temperature check, wearing masks, crowd control, presentation of Macao Health Code, maintaining social distancing, health management, medical observation, etc.
- 2) Students should take their own body temperature measurement every day. Students with fever (with ear temperature at 38°C or above /forehead temperature at 37.5°C or above), dry cough, fatigue, sore throat, diminished sense of smell (taste), diarrhea or other respiratory symptoms must put the mask on and consult a doctor promptly and must not attend classes.
- 3) Students should login to WeMust Student APP every day for health declaration. Students must truthfully and accurately fill in the information of the health declaration which cannot be modified once submitted. The Class Access Code will be generated based on the information declared by the students and the latest epidemic prevention requirements of the Macao Government and the University. Therefore, students must pay attention to the latest epidemic prevention information and comply with relevant requirements.
- 4) All students must present valid green Macao Health Code, green MUST Class Access Code and wear a mask before entering the academic buildings to participate in classes, examinations or activities. After the University has fully resumed offline teaching, students who are absent from offline classes due to failure or refusal to show the above green codes with no sufficient justification and proof will be regarded as unapproved absence.
- 5) Students who hold the yellow/red Macao Health Code or red Class Access Code should immediately notify the Faculty / Institute / Department of General Education and the class mentor so that they can assess the students' situation and the classes involved in order to make appropriate arrangements.
- 6) When attending classes and conducting related teaching activities, students must wear a mask at all times, avoid eating or drinking, and maintain at least 1 meter of social distancing. Students should also pay attention to personal and environmental hygiene to avoid cross-infection.
- Students should avoid gathering on campus, consciously take different paths to reach classroom/destination and avoid using elevators.
- 8) Students should avoid leaving Macao or commuting across borders to minimize the risk of contracting the novel coronavirus. All students should carefully assess the necessity of crossing the border and be prepared to bear the consequences of their own actions.
- 9) In case of failure to return to the University due to force majeure, students must contact the respective Faculty / Institute / Department of General Education to explain the reasons and situations, so that they can deal with their absence in light of the circumstances and provide timely academic assistance to minimize impact on their study.
- 10) The epidemic has become normalized and is constantly changing. When there is risk in the community, the University may temporarily switch to online classes so as to cooperate with the Macao SAR Government's epidemic prevention measures. Therefore, in addition to prepare for offline learning on campus, students should also prepare appropriate equipment to facilitate online learning and assessment, so as to cope with any contingency measures implemented.
- 11) Please pay attention to the latest epidemic prevention information of the Macao SAR Government (<u>https://www.ssm.gov.mo/PreventCOVID-19</u>) and latest announcements of the University, and make personal anti-epidemic measures and preparations.
