

Tuition Fee Standard for Postgraduate Programs 2023/2024

(This fee standard is for reference only, please refer to the latest announcement for the tuition fee standard of academic year of 2024)

1. Tuition Fee

A. For Macao Residents

Doctoral degree programs (except DBA): MOP60,000~66,000/academic year Master's degree programs (except EMBA): MOP63,000~72,500/academic year

Doctor of Business Administration (DBA): MOP128,000/academic year Executive Master of Business Administration (EMBA): MOP140,000/academic year

B. For Non-Macao Residents

Doctoral degree programs (except DBA): HKD100,000~136,000/academic year

Master's degree programs (except EMBA): HKD 96,500~130,000/academic year

Doctor of Business Administration (DBA): HKD165,000/academic year Executive Master of Business Administration (EMBA): HKD192,500/academic year

Notes:

- (1) Tuition fee is paid by installments, please refer to the latest notice from the Finance Office via the University homepage or Student Portal (https://i.must.edu.mo).
- (2) If students need to have course retakes or auditing, or excess course, or continue their studies beyond the normal study period etc., an additional fee shall be charged. Please refer to the latest student handbook of the University for the relevant fee schedule.

2. Caution Fee

New students must pay a caution fee before admission to any of our University program. Caution fee standard for Macao residents is MOP5,000, caution fee standard for non-Macao residents is HKD10,000 (approximately MOP10,315). Caution fee is refundable on request, after registration and deduction against any outstanding penalties or fees in arrears and upon their completion of the withdrawal procedures of the program of study.



3. Important Notes

- (1) All banking charges incurred will be borne by students.
- (2) All fees paid are neither refundable nor transferable.
- (3) Students, registered or non-registered, must accept and abide by all the clauses stated on the Tuition Fee Table.
- (4) Tuition fee adjustment may be made on the yearly basis, please refer to the latest updates. The University reserves the final right of arbitration for any disputes arising from payment of tuition fees.
