**Course Description** The aim of this course is to study and research foreign investment law, overseas investment law, bilateral and multilateral investment treaties as well as the general legal principles of these fields from comparative perspective. It provides students with both theoretical understanding and practical skills about international investment and international investment law. This course is based on two tracks. On the one hand, it focuses on private law issues confronted by international investors when operating transnational investment. On the other hand, it addresses regulatory rules made by host countries and international organizations with regard to foreign investment.
