Course selection	<p>Bachelor of Science in Management program:</p> <p>Grande Ecole Program- Undergraduate and graduate courses:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Provisional course list sent with application documents. ✓ Confirmation upon arrival during the orientation days. The choice of courses is <u>binding</u> and cannot be modified after the 1st two weeks of the semester.
Course load per semester	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Courses are credited with grades and ECTS credits. ✓ Courses generally offer 30-36 hours of lecture and require 54 or 108 hours of autonomous course work per semester. ✓ On average 7 to 8 courses per week (around 20 hours per week) are necessary to validate 30 ECTS in one semester. ✓ The course selection depends on the requirements of each home institution.

Language of instruction

- ✓ Sandwich or study work courses is a possible option for **degree-seeking students ONLY**.

- ✓ It is not possible to choose courses across different programs.

- ✓ English (some few targeted courses in French)
