Eligibility

Students who would like to apply for the Exchange Program need to hold a non-Taiwanese passport. Students with only Taiwanese nationality are not eligible for the NQU Exchange Student Program.

Students should have **B1 level for English** or Chinese Language Proficiency according to the CEFR (Common European Framework of Reference) as courses at NQU are mainly taught in Chinese or English.

The university locates in Kinmen County, Taiwan. The exchange students could travel to Kinmen through the following paths.


$\textbf{Country of Residence} {\rightarrow} \textbf{Taiwan International Airports} {\rightarrow} \textbf{Kinmen Airport}$

Notes

- 1. All exchange students are required to purchase insurance covering the entire exchange duration at NQU in Taiwan. The Insurance should include the following items:
 - i. Accident Insurance worth a minimum of NTD 1,000,000.
 - ii. Medical insurance worth a minimum of NTD 1,000,000.
- 2. To meet the government regulations, all new coming foreign exchange students must complete all required items listed in the "Health Certificate for Short-Term Students" from Taiwan Centers for Disease Control. Or students may submit a copy of vaccination certificates and the chest X-ray report instead of completing those items in the form.
