Reporting on World Heritage

The unique history of Macau has fascinated tourists around the world. Macau is located near the south-eastern coast of China, right at the crossroad between the east and the west. Before the arrival of foreigners, Macau was a quiet fishing village. After being a Portuguese colony for over 400 years, Macau was returned to China in December 1999. The architecture, culture and lifestyle are influenced by both cultures in many ways. The **Historic Centre of Macau** was inscribed on the **UNESCO World Heritage List** in 2005, making it the 31st designated World Heritage site in China. In this program, students will explore and report on their visits to these sites.

The Program includes:

- Lectures and discussions
- Site visits to UNESCO World Heritage sites
- Assignments on reporting
- Certificate will be awarded to students who have successfully completed the program
- Accommodation in the guest houses on campus

Day 3	Visit the Protestant Cemetery, Casa Garden, Camoes Garden; Ruins of St. Paul, Na Tcha Temple, the Old City Walls, Mount Fortress, Macau Museum
Day 4	Visit a local news agency, Macau Tower, Grand Prix Museum and Wine Museum, Macau Science Museum, Shopping in Venetian Hotel
Day 5	Visit the Maritime Museum, A-Ma Temple, Moorish Barracks, Lilau Square, Mandarin’s House, St. Lawrence’s Church, St. Augustine Square, Dom Pedro V Theatre, St. Joseph’s Seminary and Church, St. Augustine’s Church, Sir Robert Ho Tung Library, Former Red-light District
Day 6	Visit the Leal Senado Building and Square, Holy House of Mercy, the Cathedral, Portuguese Bookstore, Lou Kau Mansion, St. Dominic’s Church, Sam Kai Vui Kun Temple
Day 7	Discussion: Sharing experiences in this trip; Presentation of Certificates
